THEORETICAL FOUNDATIONS OF ESOGETIC MEDICINE

First described and documented 40 years ago by optometrist John Streff, EAS usually appears in girls between 5-14 years with reduced (20/100–20/400) near and far acuity, small or no refractive error, dramatically reduced visual fields and poor visual tracking and localization.
